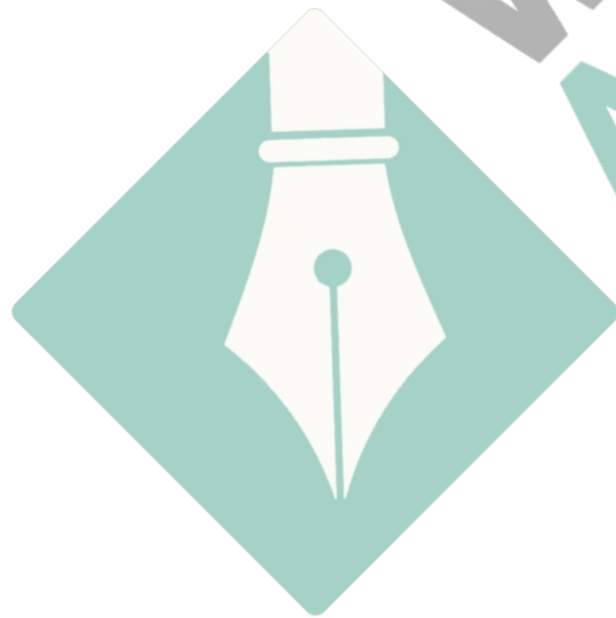

Overview of case analysis

➤ Case analysis

- Female, aged 69, Belarus, resides in one bedroom flat
- Speaks Russian and limited English
- Physical and mental health issues
- Poor home environment
- Self neglect issues
- Relies heavily on partner
- Limited social and family network

In context, the required PCFs includes 1.1, 1.2, 1.4, and 1.5. The integration of SWEPs are 3.1, 3.2, 3.3, 4.3, 4.6, and 4.7.

Overview of case analysis (Cont...)

- ▶ Potential risks due to;
 - ❑ Poor hygiene
 - ❑ Poor home environment
 - ❑ Deterioration of home
 - ❑ Uninhabitable living conditions
 - ❑ Foul smell due to unhygienic conditions

- There is a need for;
 - ❑ Mental health diagnosis
 - ❑ Assess the impacts of Covid-19 / lengthy isolated periods

The use of PCFs, integrated following human rights, value to feelings, partnership, and social justice mechanism (1.1, 1.2, 1.3, and 1.6). Also, honesty and fairness, active listening and effective communication, and law based practices and protocols (2.1, 2.3, 2.5, and 2.6).

During analysis falsification of records, abuse, and negligence were avoided (SWEPs 5.1, 5.3, and 5.5).

Evidence based recommendations for PLE, General service provision and selected research articles

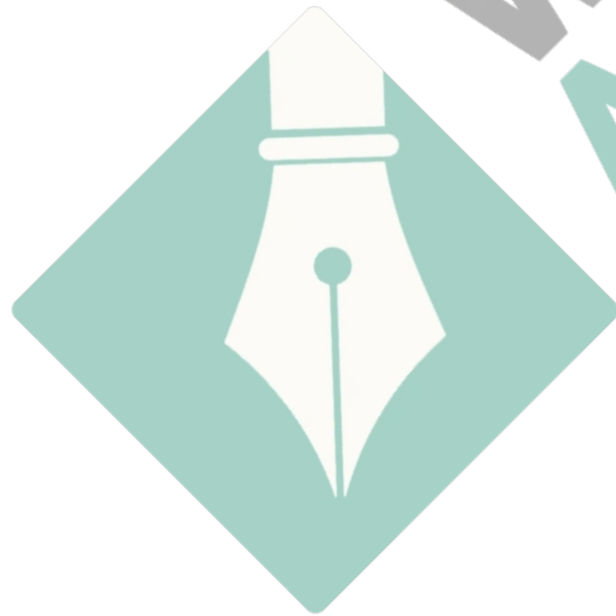
- ❑ Pest Control
- ❑ Deep clean
- ❑ Obtaining consent
- ❑ Provision of adequate housing
- ❑ Reduce barriers to accessing medical care
- ❑ Recommendation on the basis of two selected research articles (Jain et al., 2020 and Hommes et al., 2018) include;
 - ❑ Crisis Intervention to mitigate the adverse impact of Covid-19 pandemic (Jain et al., 2020)
 - ❑ Enhanced interventions for those with existing mental health diagnoses (Hommes et al., 2018).
 - ❑ Use of interpreters to overcoming the barriers to reduce the impacts of hearing difficulties (Hommes et al., 2018).
- ❑ On professional grounds:
 - ❑ Teamwork is essential in critical circumstances.
 - ❑ The use of the interpreter for multilingual conditions would be effective for value generation and effective communication and listening.
 - ❑ Future focus will be on optimized learning and practising professional standards.
 - ❑ Learning and including professional and licensed ways of using technology for real-time communication.
 - ❑ Collaborative network formation.
 - ❑ Thorough learning of legislation-based impositions for avoiding the conflicts.
